Cut, score and fold as noted paying careful attention to areas marked with "Reverse side score" arrows.

Begin by applying a bead of glue to the longest tab of the bridge wall.



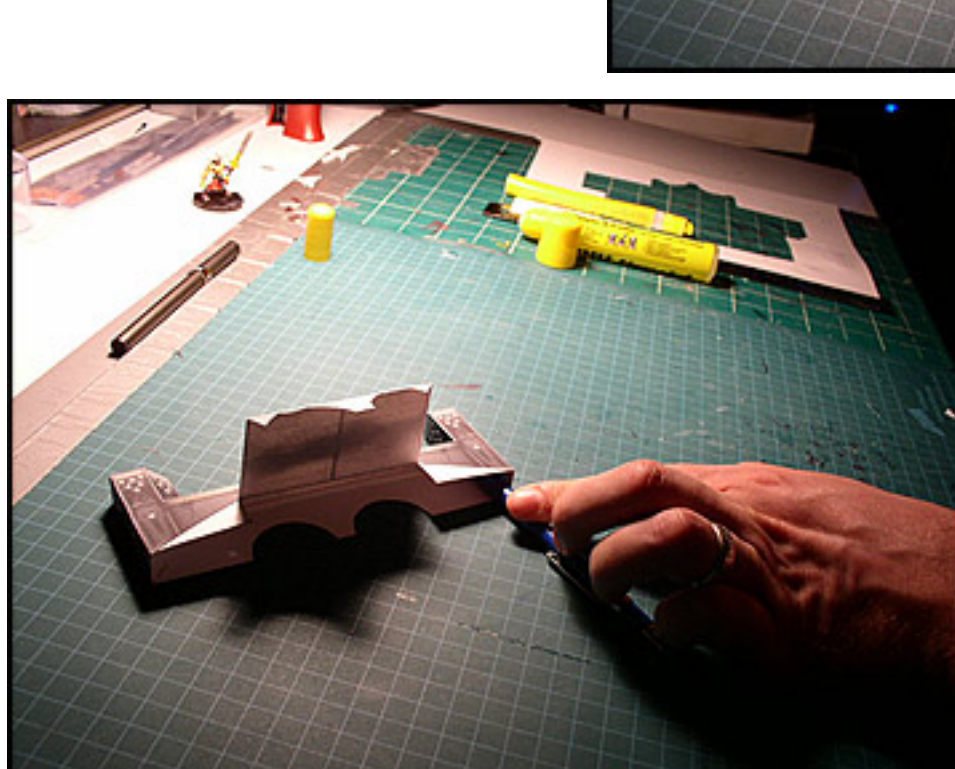
Flip the model over and apply pressure to the tab against the inside of the opposing wall. Be sure the wall section is flush before applying pressure.

Apply glue to the outer post wall glue tab (See photo).



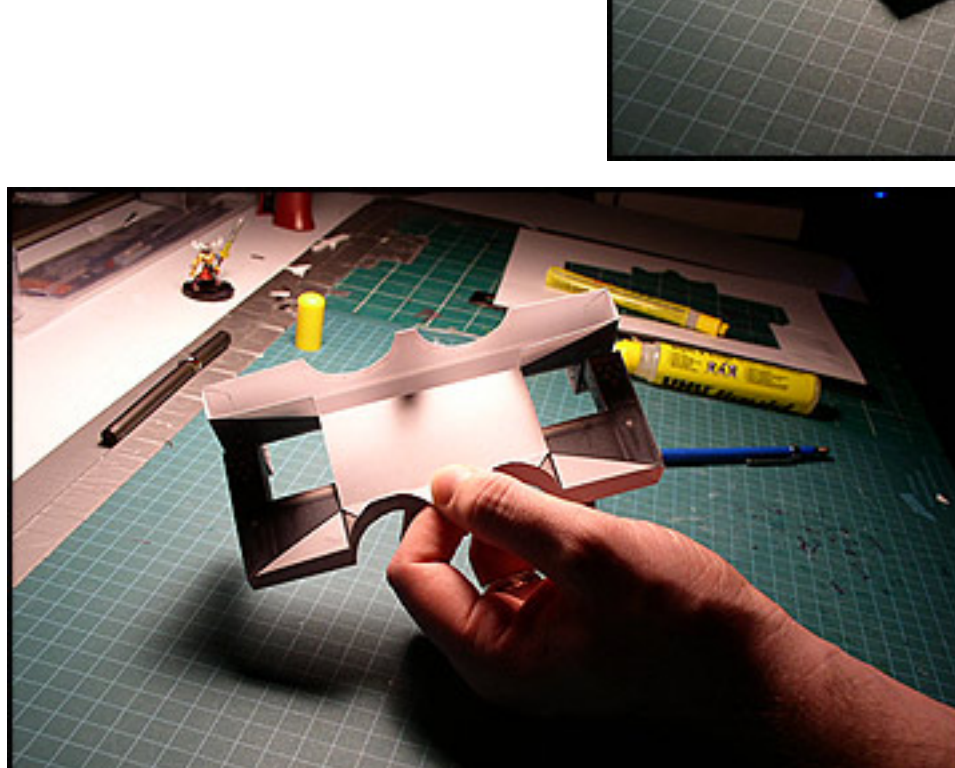
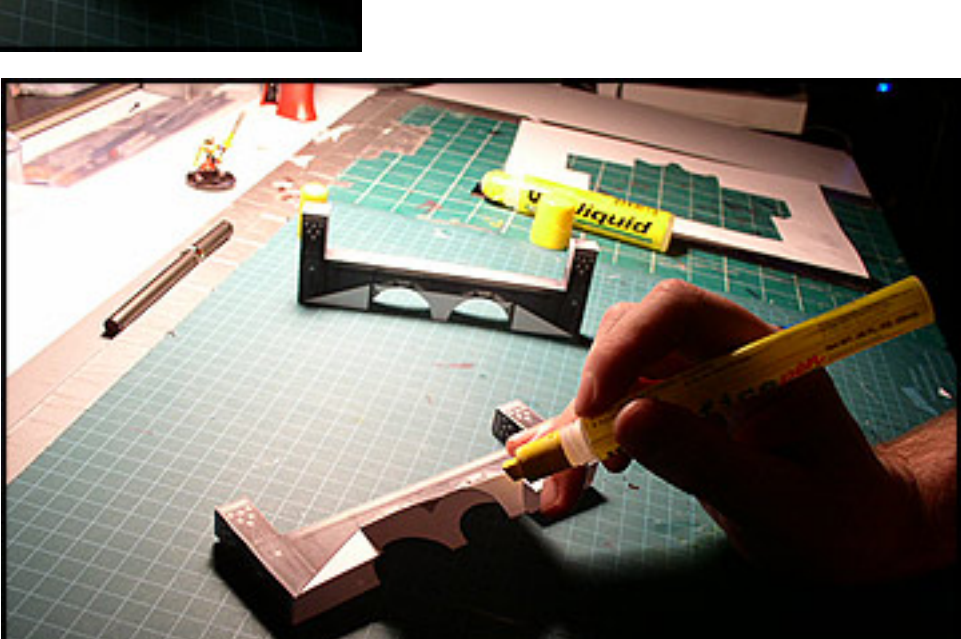
Flip the model over and apply pressure to the tab using a pencil or other skinny implement. Make sure the wall section is flush before applying pressure.

Apply a bead of glue to the inside post wall tab.



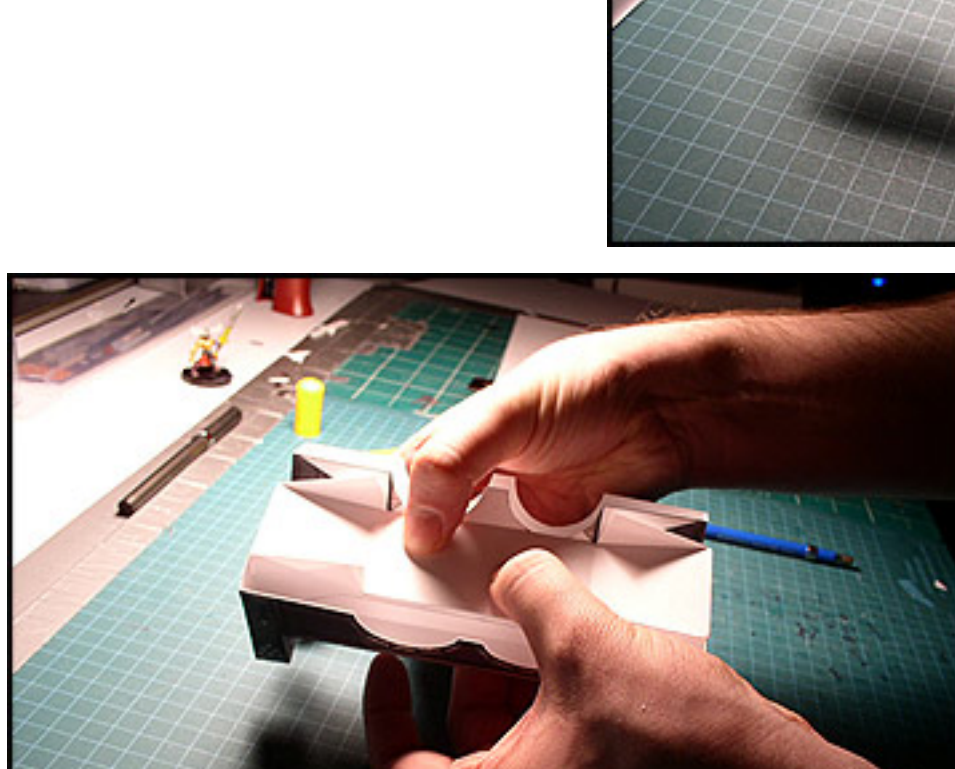
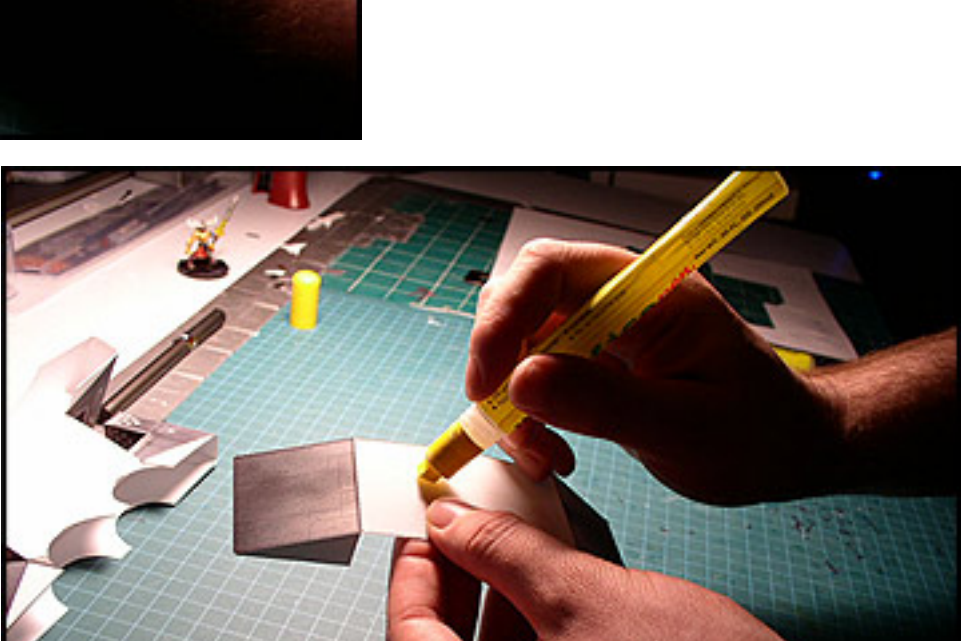
Once again, flip the model over and apply pressure to the tab using a pencil. Again, double check to make sure the section is flush before applying pressure. Now repeat the above steps to the other side of your wall and to the remaining wall section. **(You should now have both bridge walls completed before moving to the next step)**

Apply a bead of glue to the bridge floor tab attached to the bridge wall section.



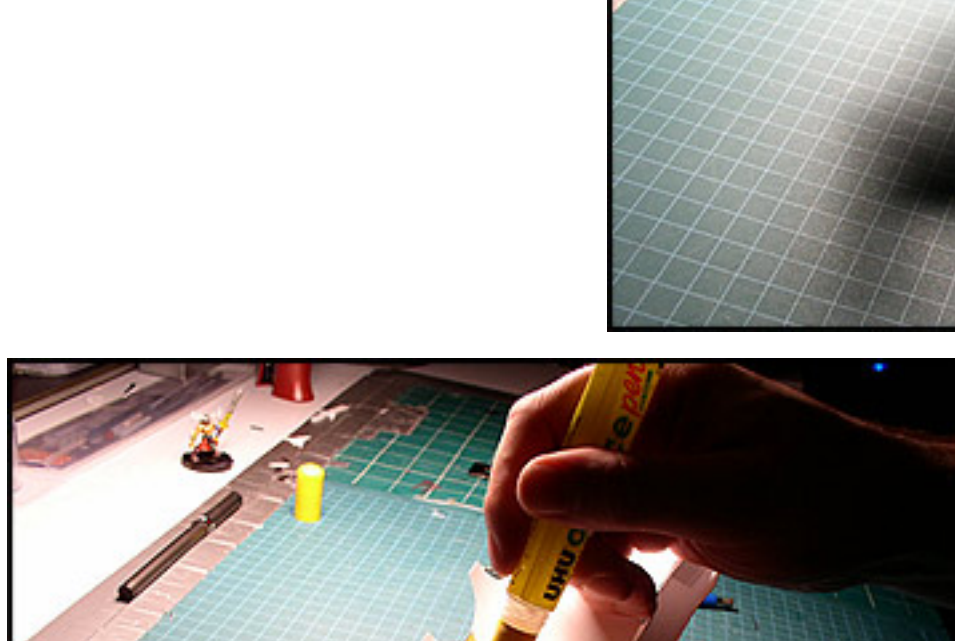
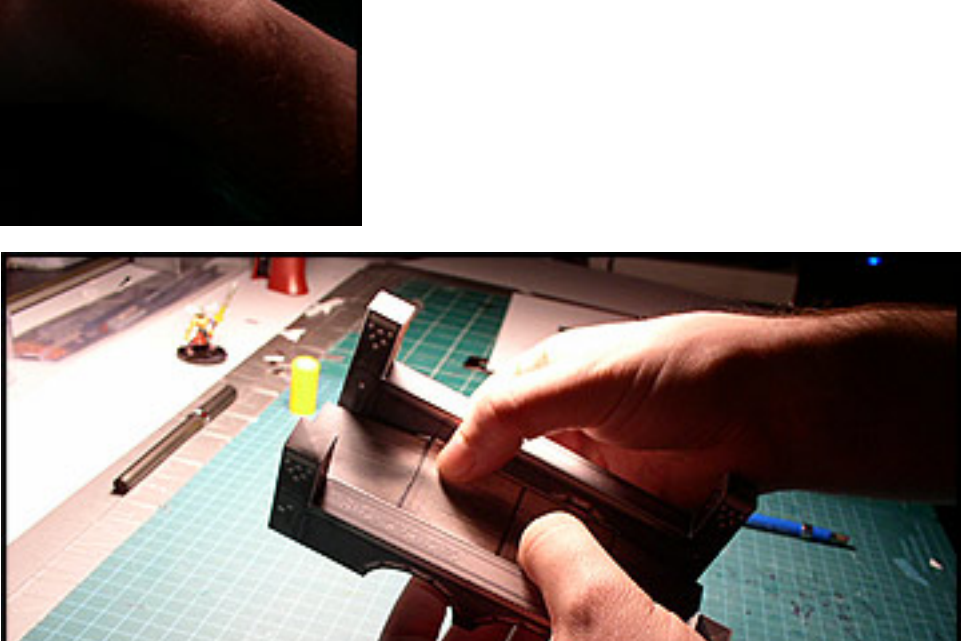
Glue and hold in place as shown in the photo. Glue this piece in place as level as is possible.

Apply glue to the top side of the remaining floor riser section.



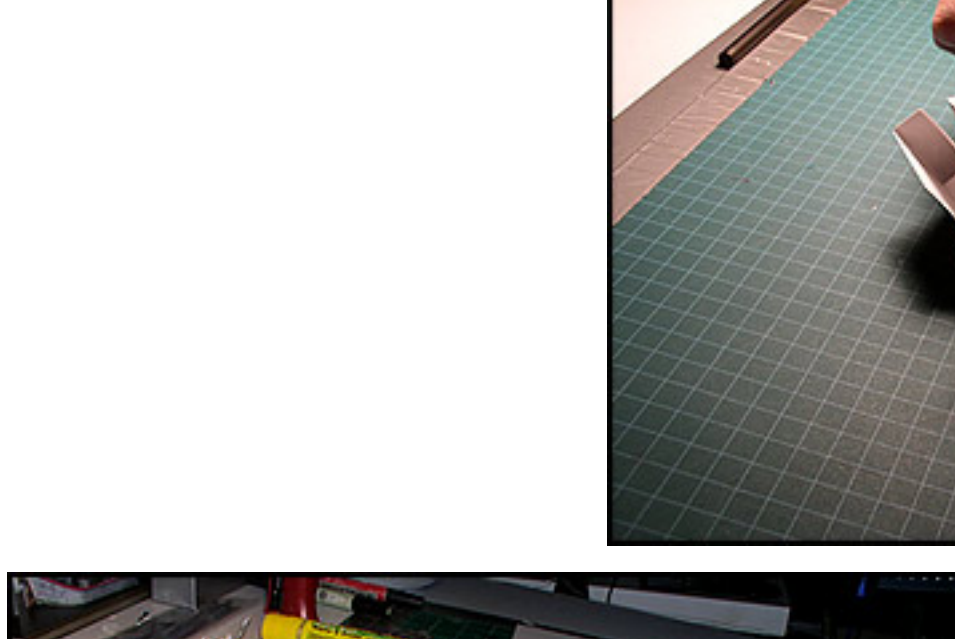
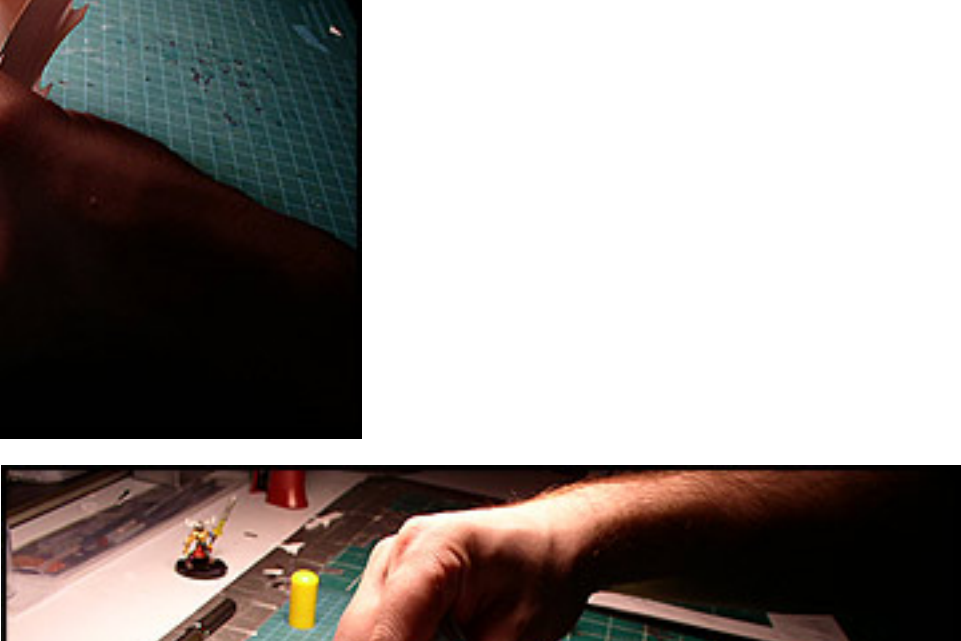
Flip the main bridge section over and lightly press in place underneath the floor.

Flip the entire model over and make sure the floor riser is centered **(No white space showing on either side of the floor)**. Now apply pressure to all areas of the floor section where glue was applied.



Flip the model over. Pull back one of the tabs and apply a bead of glue

Press in place where noted by the white space on the opposing wall and repeat this step on the remaining three tabs.



Once all the tabs are glued in place be sure to edge your model with a black or grey felt.
